THE TEST

A pattern of child's dress is provided. You are advised to study the sketches, the question paper and the layout before the test.

1. Materials provided
 - A - Front bodice
 - B - Back bodice
 - C - Front skirt
 - D - Back skirt
 - E - Pocket
 - F - Collar
 - G - Back and neck facing
2. Plain light weight cotton fabric 75cm long by 91cm wide.
3. Zip 15.3 cm long to match the colour of fabric.
4. Sewing thread to match the fabric.

This paper consists of 3 printed pages. Candidate should check to ascertain that all pages are printed as indicated and that no questions are missing.

THE TEST

Using the materials provided, cut out and make up the **LEFT HALF** of the child's dress showing the following.

- a) The making of the shoulder dart.
- b) The making of machine fell seam at the shoulder.
- c) The joining of the front and back neck facings at the shoulder and neatening the free edge of the joined facings.
- d) The preparation of an interfaced collar.
- e) The attaching of the collar using the joined facings.
- f) The attaching of the bodice pieces to the skirts pieces and neatening the back part only.
- g) The making and neatening of an open seam at the side. Attach the zip into the seam using concealed method.
- h) The preparation and attaching of the pocket.

OMIT

The management of the lower hem and sleeve hem.

At the end of the examination, firmly sew on to your work, on a single fabric, a label bearing your name and index number.

Remove needles and pins from your work, then fold your work carefully and place it in the envelop provided.

Do not put scraps of materials in the envelop.
