1. a) How Jesus fulfilled prophecies of the suffering servant

- i. He was mocked and despised
- ii. He was rejected as the messiah
- iii. He was pierced and wounded
- iv. He was arrested and tried
- v. He submissively suffered without complain
- vi. He was crucified on the cross
- vii. He bore the sins of human beings
- viii. He was buried in a rich man's tomb
- ix. He rose from the dead
- x. He is exalted by God/seated at right hand of God.

b) Teachings of John the Baptist about messiah

- i. Messiah is God's prophet
- ii. He is greater than John the Baptist/cannot until laces
- iii. He is the son of God / the Christ
- iv. Would baptize with fire and the holy spirit
- v. He would pass judgment to an repentant
- vi. He is righteous hence needs repentant
- vii. Would reinforce Gods laws
- viii. Will separate the righteous from sinners
- ix. Shall exalt/ reward repentant to eternity
- x. Will bring God's salvation to humanity

2.a) describe the call of the first disciple Lk 5:1-11

- i. As he stood by the shores of Lk Gennesaret preaching to a large crowd, he saw two boats at the shore.
- ii. Boats were left by fishermen who were washing their nets
- iii. He got into one of the boats of Simon and taught the crowd while in the boat
- iv. Then he told Simon to cast the nets back to the water for a catch
- v. Simon answered that they have worked whole night but have caught nothing
- vi. He later cast the net to the water because Jesus had said so
- vii. In no time the net was full of fish that it began to break
- viii. The fisherman signaled to their partners in the other boat to assist them
- ix. Simon fell at Jesus feet and confessed his sins
- x. Jesus told him (Simon) not to be worried for from then henceforth he shall be fisher of men
- xi. Simon, John and James then pulled boat to the shore, left everything there and followed Christ

- vi. Jesus influence is so great/influence people to praise God
- vii. Jesus is courageous/did not fear religion leaders

3. a) why Jesus wept in Jerusalem

- i. People of Jerusalem did not realize his arrival
- ii. They did not recognize him as a peaceful messiah
- iii. They were engaged in sinfulness /forgotten covenant way of life
- iv. Had forgotten Gods election and role to do his will to other nations
- v. It was the centre of worshiping God but was spiritually dead
- vi. Religious leaders had forgotten the laws that they kept and taught
- vii. Jesus had foreseen his rejection in Jerusalem
- viii. Jerusalem was going to be punished/destroyed

b) Describe the trials of Jesus Lk 22:66-23

Jesus before the Sanhedrin

- i. He was asked if he was the Christ
- ii. He responded that they would not believe him
- iii. He said hat soon he would be seated in the right hand of mighty God
- iv. They asked him if he was the son of God
- v. He responded that they have said so

Jesus before Pilate

- i. Pilate asked him if he was the king of Jews and Jesus replied that he had said so
- ii. Pilate told the Sanhedrin that he had seen no crime in him

Jesus before Herod

- i. Herod was gland to see him and expected some sign from him
- ii. Herod asked him several question and never answered any
- iii. Herod and soldiers treated him with contempt and mockery by dressing him in kings attire

Jesus before Pilate

- i. Pilate confirmed his innocence even from Herod not worth dying but only to be chastised
- ii. Crowd shouted at pilate to release Barnabas and crucify Jesus
- iii. Pilate then passed sentence that peoples demand be done on Jesus be crucification

- i. Told the crowd that disciples were not drunk.
- ii. Revealed that prophet Joel talked about the event
- iii. Preached that Jesus did God's will e.g. miracle
- iv. He said that Jesus suffering /death was God's plan
- v. He said that Jesus rose from death and exalted by God
- vi. He talked of Davids prophecy about his descendant who had to take his throne i.e Jesus Christ.
- vii. Jesus is the lord and the Christ
- viii. He challenged people to repent and be baptized in Jesus name the holy
- ix. Told the people that repentants shall receive the gift
- x. He pleaded with people to save /separate themselves from the corrupt generation

b) How Paul used human body to demonstrate unity of believers (1cor 12-27)

- i. Body part represented believers /the church
- ii. The human head represented Jesus Christ
- iii. Just as the head/brain controls body parts so is Jesus coordinating act of believers
- iv. Each believer/body part has its unique role to play towards the whole body /church
- v. Each believer is important in the church
- vi. No believer should despise/reject others
- vii. Even the underprivileged /disregarded members are needed in the church e.g. children
- viii. Each believer is baptized with some spirit to make them one
- ix. Each believer is a rightful member of the church
- x. The less honorable believer should be treated with modesty
- xi. Believers should show equal concern for one another in joy and sadness

- i. To promote oneness in Christ
- ii. To promote Jesus teachings
- iii. To share the scarce resources
- iv. To achieve effective evangelism.
- v. To develop common /regular way of worship

- viii. Have common stand in dealing with issues e.g. rigging, corruption.

- i. Raped develop self pity/regret/blame
- ii. Both may contract STI & AIDS
- iii. Causes injuries/physical damage to raped
- iv. Kills self esteem /dignity of raped
- v. Leads to loss of virginity
- vi. The raped may develop aggressiveness towards men
- vii. The raped develops withdrawal traits/reject sexual relationship
- viii. Leads to stereotype /hatred for all men
- ix. Unwanted pregnancies result/illegitimate child
- x. Leads to imprisonment of resourceful persons
- xi. Leads to conflicts /denial by family members
