1. a) Give the contents of the Mary's Bible magnificent 6 marks
- i. Her soul magnifies the lord
  - ii. Her spirit rejoices in God her saviour
  - iii. The lord has regarded the low estate of his handmaiden
  - iv. All generations will call her blessed
  - v. The mighty one has done great things for her
  - vi. The lord's mercy is of those who fear him
  - vii. He has shown straight with his arm
  - viii. He has scattered the proud
  - ix. He has put down the mighty from them thrown and exalted those of low degree
  - x. He has helped his servant Israel 6 x 1 = 6mks
- b) From the story of life and works of John the Baptist identify ways through which he is seen as coming from a poor background 6 marks
- i. He led a life of a Nazarine
  - ii. He fed an grass hoppers & honey in the wildness
  - iii. His teachings on sharing depicted that he lacked
  - iv. His preaching on justice and tax collectors indicated that he lacked
  - v. His criticism of Herod and Herodias which earned his death showed he was poor
  - vi. He was very simple yet great 1 x 6 = 6mks
- c) Give reasons why women have dominated church activities in Kenya 8 marks
- i. They are the majority in our churches
  - ii. They are better believers than the male counterparts
  - iii. It is in the church where full recognition has matured in Kenya/ condemn sensitivity
  - iv. This is because of their very nature of accommodative of situation
  - v. They are more loving/ caring
  - vi. When they sing the choir is enriched hence more believers
  - vii. They take time in their area of a specialization
  - viii. Most of the church activities like choir/ bible reading / cleaning the church they are famine
  - ix. They are less critical to issues in the church than men
  - x. They receive consolation from the church which satisfy them
  - xi. During fellowship they really encourage one another
2. a) Describe the works and activities of Jesus after his Baptism 1 x 8=8 marks
- i) He was led by the Holy spirit to the wildness where he stayed for 40 days
  - ii) He was tempted by Satan in 3 fold i.e. showed a kingdom / turning stones into bread/ jumping from the pillar of the roof unhurt
  - iii) He preached in the synagogue at Nazareth on the Sabbath day
  - iv) He gave a sermon on the plains
  - v) He taught the beatitudes
  - vi) He used parables in his teaching
  - vii) He prayed earnestly and light about prayers
  - viii) He visited his friends and taught them i.e. the sons of thinder ( the zebedees)
  - ix) He instructed the disciples where cast them nets and the wonderful catch
  - x) He called his apostles and delegated to them duties
  - xi) He commissioned the 72 disciples in the missionary work
  - xii) His trumpet entry to Jerusalem
  - xiii) He prayed at Mt olives and the subsequent arrest 1 x 8 = 8mks
- b) What lessons do Christians learn from the healing miracles of Jesus Christ 5 marks
- i) He is merciful / loving
  - ii) He is full of compassion

- iii) He saves life
- iv) He hates suffering
- v) It is part and parcel of the salvation
- vi) Out of faith a lot can be achieved
- vii) Jesus destroyed the kingdom of satan and establishing the kingdom of God
- viii) He came for the needy
- ix) He used the divine authoritative word to heal
- x) It established thorough confidence in the believers 1x 5=5 marks
- c) Identify problems faced by the church leaders today in Kenya 7 marks
  - i) Power wrangles
  - ii) Politics has been brought in the church
  - iii) Defection from the parent church
  - iv) Financial conflicts
  - v) Tribalism amongst them
  - vi) Different ideology i.e. should women be ordained priests. The day of Sabbath. How should Baptism be administered
  - vii) Sacrificing faith & virtues in exchange of financial gains
  - viii) Educational standards / levels attained by their leaders
  - ix) Use of pre- arranged miracles in order to pull crowd
  - x) Scandals like Bishop Dey's theft child

- xi) Fear of mixing Satan with Jesus 1 x 7 = 7mks
- 3 a) Outline the events that took place in Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem 7 marks
- As Jesus approached Bethphage and Bethany. He sent two of his disciples to go ahead of him to a village
  - Jesus instructed them to untie a colt which no one had ridden before and take it to him.
  - Those sent for the colt as had been instructed and untied it.
  - The owners of the colt asked them why they wanted the colt and replied that Jesus' lord had need
  - They brought the colt, threw their cloaks on it and Jesus climbed
  - The whole crowd joyfully praised the lord in loud voices and spread their garments on the road
  - The Pharisees in the crowd asked Jesus to rebuke the disciples
  - Jesus replied that if the disciples would be quiet then the stones would shout
  - As he approached Jerusalem Jesus wept over the city 1 x 7 = 7mks
- b) Give reasons why Thomas was doubtful about Jesus' resurrection 8 marks
- i) He lacked enough faith
  - ii) He had not seen/ witnessed resurrection before
  - iii) He had expected messiah who would establish an earthly kingdom
  - iv) His hopes about messiah were dazzled by the death
  - v) It was unbelievable at that time
  - vi) He had not recognized the messiah of Jesus' / his divinity
  - vii) He wanted to fulfill the belief that seeing is believing 2 x 4 = 8mks
- c) Explain the significance of Jesus' resurrection to the Christians 5 marks
- i) It is the king post of the faith
  - ii) There would be no Christianity without resurrection
  - iii) It meant Jesus defeated death
  - iv) It confirmed that indeed Jesus was the son of God / divine
  - v) Resurrection gives the Christ's hope of their own resurrection after death
  - vi) They will resurrect in spirit form as Christ
  - vii) It actualized the final defeat of the satanic kingdom and established Messianic kingdom
  - viii) It was full realization of his salvation 1 x 5 = 5mks
4. a) Describe the healing of the woman who touched Jesus' garments (Lk 8: 43-48)
- i) As Jesus was passing people pressed around him
  - ii) A woman who had a flow of blood for 12 years and could not be healed
  - iii) She came behind Jesus and touched the fringe of his garments

- iv) Immediately her flow of blood ceased
- v) Jesus said “ who was is that touched the fringe of my garments “
- vi) when all denied it, peter said, master the multitudes surround you and press upon you”
- vii) Jesus insisted that someone touched him as he perceived power has gone form him.
- viii) The woman saw that and came trembling and falling down before him and declared herself
- ix) Jesus told her “daughter, your faith has made you well. 1 x 6 =6mks

b) Explain Jesus teaching on the role of the Holy spirit 6 marks

- i) Holy spirit would guide the believers in truth
- ii) Holy spirit would be a gift to those who love Jesus and His commandments
- iii) Holy spirit helps believers to send away the evil spirit e.g. Jesus gave his disciples power and authority over the evil spirit
- iv) Holy spirit will give glory to Jesus/tell the believers what Jesus says
- v) Holy spirit reveals the truth to the believers / teach the believers everything
- vi) Holy spirit gives life to the believers
- vii) Holy spirit gives those who proclaim the gospel the words to speak
- viii) Holy spirit will make people be filled with power / act as His witness 1 x 6 =6mks

c) In what ways are talents misused by Christians in Kenya 8 marks

- i) Failure to identify our talents
- ii) Failure in tapping the talents by the government
- iii) Lack of initiative on the part of the individual
- iv) What the talent can earn the individual is never encompassed
- v) Drug and substance abuse
- vi) Poor exposure/ lack of it
- vii) Jealousy form those in position
- viii) Fear of a challenge / tuppled
- ix) Poverty
- x) Lack of competition which can sharpen it
- xi) Bm ideology i.e. sectionalism/ racism / tribalism
- xii) Lack of faith and confidence in tribalism
- xiii) Lack of faith and confidence in the individuals. 1 x 8 = 8mks

5. a) Outline the parable of the great feasts Lk 14: 16- 24 6 marks

- i) A man gave a feast and invited many guest
- ii) When it was time, he sent his servant for the guest
- iii) The invited gave excuses and did not come
- iv) One said he had bought a field and must attend to it
- v) Another said he bought oxen and had to try them out in the field
- vi) One had just married and could not leave his new bride
- vii) The servant reported these excuses to their master
- viii) The master was annoyed and sent them to the streets to bring the poor / land / blind / cripple to the feast
- ix) None of the invited guest was to taste the feast 1 x 6 =6mks

b) What is the significance of baptism in the Christian life 6 marks

- i) It makes one be a child of God
- ii) It makes one to be a member of the church
- iii) From baptism one begins the life journey of a Christian
- iv) It plants the seed of Christ in the heart/ lights and removes darkness of Satan.
- v) A baptized Christian has fully been commissioned to do all that befits a Christian to undertake
- vi) Without baptism, one is not legible being called a Christian
- vii) One gets a new name which represent the angel gurdian of the individual
- viii) It makes one to be a changed person new beginning of life
- ix) One can now undertake some duties in the church as a full members
- x) One can partake in the Holy commission during the celebration 1 x 6 = 6mks

c) Explain the biblical teaching on wealth 8 marks

- i) Wealth is a gift / blessings from God
- ii) Wealth should be shared with the needy eg the rich man and Lazarus

- iii) Wealth should be used to glorify God/ giving tithe
- iv) Wealth should be used to spread the word of God / Christianity
- v) Worldly riches should not be a hindrance to entering the kingdom of God
- vi) Christians should seek for spiritual wealth more than worldly riches
- vii) Christians should store their wealth in heaven where moths can not destroy it
- viii) The poor should not be jealous of the rich
- ix) Christians should work positively to get wealth
- x) The rich should not be proud / use their riches to oppress the poor. 1x8 =8mks

6. a) Explain how irresponsible leisure's activities can interfere with the Christian way of life 8 marks

- i) Abuse of drug and substance can make drive false satisfaction instead of God
- ii) Illicit sex can make one feel shy not to attend church services
- iii) Financial scandal can make one loose integrity hence failure to attend church
- iv) Drunkardness may make one not to have time for church
- v) Disco jokers may want to entertain funs on the day of prayers or eve of the prayers
- vi) Money matters/ Greed for money may make one forget about God
- vii) Greed for power may make one to become corrupt
- viii) Conformity with others may lead to irrational decision making hence injustice
- ix) Sponsoring of dangerous games like boxing / bull, fighting which may lead to death
- x) Stealing / magging of people can make one be a jail bird or die on the process as one wants cheap life 1 x 8=8mks

b) Identify effects of injustice in the Kenyan society 7 marks

- i) It leads to death of the innocent
- ii) It leads to loss of property
- iii) Sometimes people are displaced
- iv) It interferes with production especially of food and other basic goods
- v) Plants the seeds of discontents
- vi) Breeds rebellion against the offender
- vii) It is expensive to rehabilitate
- viii) Loss of jobs / positions.
- ix) Crime rate is escalated 1 x 7=7mks
- x) Virtues are not upheld/ buried deep in the ground
- xi) Low esteem to produce.
- xii) It breeds and exposes animalism in man 1 x 7=7mks

c) How has science and technology impacted negatively on the spread of Christianity 6 marks

- i) Some members of the church attend because of entertainment / dancing
- ii) There is competition in the type of machines used/ noise pollution'
- iii) The machines are expensive
- iv) Some church songs have been corrupted by politicians
- v) Lack of keenness in the message to be communicated / lack of alertness
