- Jesus went with them.
- When Jesus was approaching the centurion's house he sent friends to stop him from going to his house/say only a word.
- When Jesus heard this he marveled at him and turned and said to the multitude that he had not seen such faith in Israel.
- When they returned to the house they found the slave well.

b) Identify six reasons why Jesus was rejected at Nazareth.
{6mks}

- He was simply the son of Joseph the carpenter whom they knew
- Jesus read the prophecy of Isaiah and told them it had been fulfilled in him/he claimed to be the messiah.
- Jesus did not perform the miracles he did in Capernaum.
- Jesus annoyed the listeners when he told them that their forefathers had rejected/persecuted God's prophets
- He told them that a prophet is not welcomed in his home town.
- Jesus compared them with unfavourably with the gentiles e.g Elijah and Elisha performing miracles among the Gentiles so the Jews felt insulted.
- Jesus told them that the good news had first been offered to the Jews but because they rejected it, it was now available to the Gentiles.

- Christians provide free/affordable medical services for the sick.
- They give financial/material assistance to the sick.
- They provide guidance and counseling services for the sick.
- They construct hospitals/mobile clinics/recreational facilities for the sick.
- They train medical personnel to offer health services.
- They accept them in the church/preaching messages of hope to them.
- They pray for the sick.
- They participate in cleaning the environment for good health.
- They visit/encourage the sick.
- They build rehabilitation centres where they care for the sick.

- Those who humble themselves will be exalted.

- It is blessed to invite the poor/maimed/lame/blind to the feast instead of ones' relatives/friends who can invite you in return.
- Those who do good for the less fortunate will be repaid during the resurrection of the just.

- The centurion who witnessed the death of Jesus praised GOD/CONFESSED THAT Jesus was an innocent man.
- The multitude who witnessed the death beat their breasts as they went away.
- The women/acquaintances from Galilee stood at a distance/watched in silence.
- Joseph of Arimathea went to pilate to ask for the body of Jesus .
- He took down the body from the cross and wrapped it in linen clothes/laid it in a tomb.
- The women from Galilee followed Joseph /saw the tomb /how the body was laid.
