- (ii) I would use -Appropriate gestures.  
 -Appropriate facial expressions.  
 -Appropriate tonal variation.  
 -Appropriate costumes. (Any 2 = 2 marks)
- (iii) It the audience -Sits in the right posture showing that they are attentive.  
 -Nods their heads in the course of the narration.  
 -Wears appropriate facial expression that indicates they are concentrating.  
 -Maintain eye contact with the one reciting the poem.  
 -Claps in the course of the recitation. (Any 2 = 2 marks)
