1. COMPREHENSION.

1. If they smoke or drink liquor in the presence of their children, the children interpret it as being permission for them to drink and smoke. 2mks
2. Because they lead to the taking of more potent drugs /hard drugs such as cocaine. 2mks
3. Because mostly, it is the teenage sellers who supply the drugs that students use 2mks
4. Drugs influence their thinking 1mk, their attitudes and moods 1mk, drugs make the circumstances of life seem different from reality 1mk. Drugs make the users feel comfortable, peaceful and secure in spite of their problems, anxieties or inabilities 1mk

2. NARRATIVE
